**Professor Henry "Harry" Elderfield**, FRS, (born 1943), was Professor of Ocean Geochemistry and Palaeochemistry at the Godwin Laboratory, Department of Earth Sciences, Cambridge University. He was recognised for his contributions with several notable awards including the Lyell Medal in 2003 and the V. M. Goldschmidt in 2013. Harry was much loved and respected academic, teacher and mentor in our department. His death is a profound loss.
